

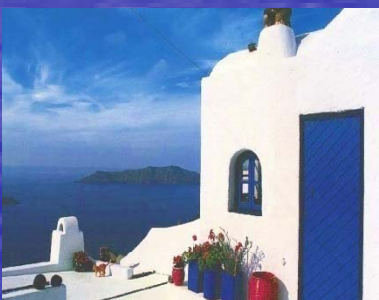

Program Costs

- The cost of the trip : US \$3,195 to be made in three installments:
 - \$300 when you sign up to reserve your place (First-come first-served).
 - \$1,500 by April 4, 2009.
 - The remainder, \$1,395, is due on May 4, 2009/
