We will then travel to The Hague, Netherlands, the home of the International Court of Justice and International Criminal Courts, and Amsterdam. The trip will conclude by exploring Brussels, the headquarters of the European Union and NATO. You will also have free time to explore each city on your own.

Through this class, you will experience the best of Europe up-close and in person, and grow into more of a global citizen.
